Refund Information - CREDITS ONLY

No tuition will be refunded after the FIRST meeting of the class. Credit requests must be made in writing and received by the Community School prior to the meeting of the first scheduled class. Credits may not be used toward Garden State Getaway trips or Education Services Center SAT classes.

Cancelled Classes

The Community School is a non-profit organization and must rely on tuition fees to run programs. Classes cannot be offered unless they are self-sustaining.
