- Students will complete a lesson from the Envision textbook which will include a short video and some examples in the book. Students may also have some handouts and/or guided notes that go along with the lesson.

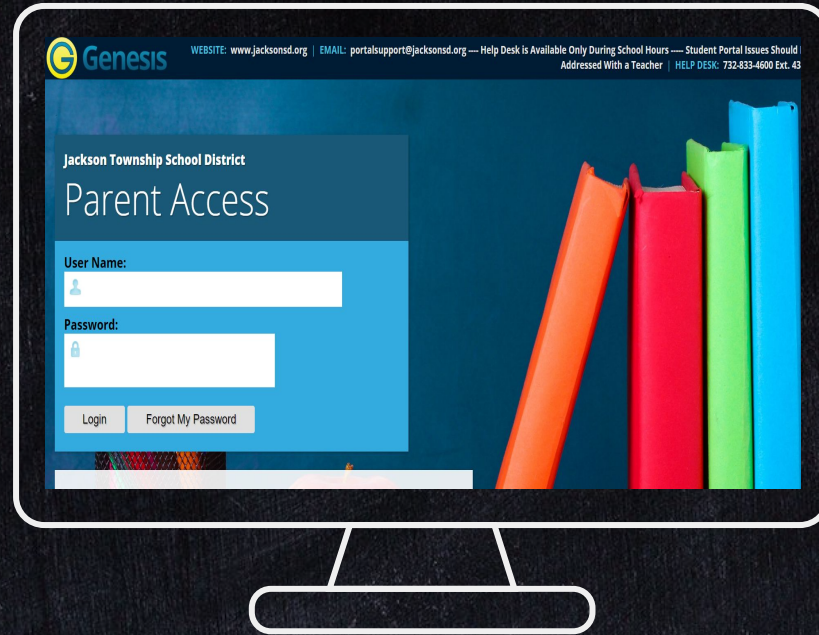
Homework

Homework 20%



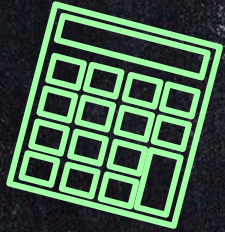
Homework and Classwork

Homework is graded with a check system. The teacher is looking for all work completed with work shown when necessary. The teacher will mark the homework with the following:

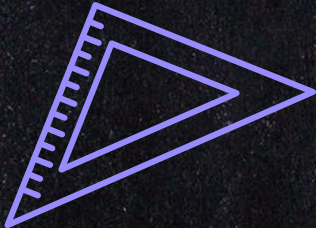
✓	++ (100%)	complete and turned in on time with no or few incorrect answers.
✓	+ (85%)	incomplete or one day late with few incorrect answers.
✓	(78%)	incomplete or day late with several incorrect answers.
✓	- (72%)	two days late with few incorrect answers.
✓	-- (67%)	two or more days late
0	(0%)	not turned in
