(Do a “TumbleSearch” in the upper right corner of the screen.)</p> <p>Answer this question: What are some rhyming word pairs you heard in the story? Can you name some more rhyming words?</p>	<p>These are some <i>optional</i> activities for your child:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go to PebbleGo. (username: engaged password: learning) 2. Click on the link that says “Animals” with a picture of a lion. 3. Next click on the picture of a Tyrannosaurus Rex with the word “Dinosaurs.” Learn about different dinosaurs. 4. Print out an activity to label the parts of one kind of dinosaur you learn about. Or draw your own picture of a dinosaur! 5. Check out more facts when you click the purple “Dinosaurs” link on the main PebbleGo screen.
