Then find the story titled Families Around the World by Clare Lewis and read a Non-Fiction (real) book about different families. 4. Draw and color a picture showing your family.

Sonny gets up early every morning to work for the coal man before school. He hears the “trumpet players blowing their horns.” Listen to some Jazz music and try to identify a trumpet, a French horn and a trombone. 2.
