

2021 Jackson Liberty Homecoming Dance COVID Guidelines

The following are guidelines that must be adhered to while attending the 2021 Jackson Liberty Homecoming Dance on October 9th. Please review these guidelines, sign, have a parent/guardian sign, and bring with you to the dance on the 9th. Failure to hand in a signed copy of these guidelines will result in not being permitted to attend the dance. If you are bringing a Jackson Memorial guest, that student must also have a form signed by them and their parent/guardian and it is the responsibility of the Liberty student to give them the form.

Date:	October 9, 2021 (no rain date)
Location:	Socrates Patio at JLHS (OUTSIDE)
Time:	5:00 PM - 8:00 PM
Ticket Price:	\$10 single, \$15 couple (advanced), \$15 per person at the door

Students must show up to the dance by 5:30. While at the dance, students will be asked to maintain a proper social distance as best as possible. Dancing with a certain group of students may limit the number of students who will need to quarantine should a positive COVID case be reported.

In the event a student tests positive for COVID, nurses and administrators will conduct interviews to determine who may be considered a close contact and will need to quarantine due to contact tracing.

Keep the quarantine guidelines in mind. Anyone who is exposed to a positive COVID individual would need to quarantine if unvaccinated and closer than 6 feet for more than 15 minutes over a 24 hour period.

By signing this form, you give permission to attend and understand the possibility that your child may be required to quarantine due to testing positive for COVID or from being determined to be a close contact of a COVID positive student.
