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## **School Responsibilities**

The staff and parents/guardians at Crawford-Rodriguez School have high expectations of themselves and of the students at the school. In an effort to provide the highest quality instructional program to the students at Crawford-Rodriguez School and to show how the school and family are working together to educate the students at Crawford-Rodriguez, the staff and parents/guardians of Crawford-Rodriguez students agree to implement the following programs and activities:

- Provide an academic program that is rigorous and challenging for all students to meet achievement standards.
- Create a learning environment where everyone is respected and working cooperatively.
- Communicate with families on an on-going basis regarding the student's academic progress.
- Hold parent-teacher conferences (at least annually in elementary schools) during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual student's achievement.
- Implement a before/after school program called SOAR for K, 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students from October to April.
- Implement a before/after school program called Reach for Success for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade students from October to April.
- Provide parents reasonable access to staff and opportunities to participate in school related activities.
- All Basic Skills identified students will be afforded the opportunity to participate in our "Achieving with iPads", a one to one iPad initiative. Students in grades 1-5 will have iPads to use in the classroom throughout the school day and during our after school program. Students in grades 3, 4, and 5 will also be allowed to take the iPads home for academic use once parents have attended the mandatory district iPad training and signed the iPad use agreement.

## **Parent/Guardian Responsibilities**

The school and families of Crawford-Rodriguez students recognize that while both parties agree that the *expectations* listed here are necessary in order to strengthen the communication and commitment between the home and the school, rare occasions may arise where one or both parties will have difficulty fulfilling all or part of this agreement. It is also recognized that the school's purpose is to *support* the community and its *families* in whatever manner is necessary and reasonable to its ability to do so, and *likewise*, it is the family's responsibility to support the child and the school community.

- Will send their children to school prepared to learn.
- Will read to their children as often as possible.
- Will attend at *least one parent/teacher conference* a year to discuss academic progress of their children.
- Will continue to assist their children with homework assignments on a regular basis to ensure completeness and accuracy.

## **Student Responsibilities**

I, as a student, will share the responsibility to improve our academic achievement and achieve the State's high standards. Specifically, I will:

- Do my homework every day and ask for help when I need to.
- Read at least 30 minutes every day outside of school time.
- Give to my parents or the adult who is responsible for my welfare all notices and information received by me from my school every day.
