CHRISTA McAULIFFE MIDDLE SCHOOL SOCIAL PROBATION EXCLUSION

Starting Monday, APRIL 1, 2019

- 1. Exclusion from all after school and evening activities, including team sports.
- 2. Exclusion from participation in the 8th grade class trip.
- 3. Exclusion from participation in the 8th grade dance.
- 4. Exclusion from participation in Promotional Ceremony.

The following infractions are all serious in nature and may result in the student receiving a suspension from school. Conduct probation will be assigned, at the discretion of the administrator, on a case by case basis. Students' prior discipline record will be considered.

- 1. Fighting
- 2. Intimidation including verbal assault and threats
- 3. Verbal sexual harassment/abuse
- 4. Religious, sexual, ethnic or disability harassment
- 5. **Sexual contact/abuse**
- 6. Racially offensive language
- 7. Bullying/Cyber Bullying
- 8. Theft of property
- 9. Smoking and/or possession of cigarettes, lighters, matches
- 10. Possession of fireworks

The Board of Education District Policy Requires 10 Days of Out of School Suspension Consequence for the Following Offenses:

- Assault of a Student or School Employee
- Possession of a Weapon
- Making a Terroristic Threat
- Possession and/or use of Drugs and Alcohol
- Repeated Fighting (3 or more times)

<u>In Addition:</u> <u>Students will be on conduct probation for six weeks beginning with the first day of the suspension.</u> This means students will not be permitted to practice in nor participate in any type of sports, clubs, and special events/functions or in any other capacity of the school's extra curricular programs. This also includes class trips, dances/socials and class activities that take place after school and during the evening hours.
