#### Reader's Workshop:

- independent reading
- conferencing with the teacher

- writing about their ideas.
- Book clubs (fiction) and Westward Expansion (non-fiction).

### WRITING

#### Writer's Workshop:

- Narrative writing
- informational writing
- opinion/argument writing.
- Learning how to become a better writer by observing what professional writers have done

### VOCAB/GRAMMAR

Vocab: Students will learn about words including spelling, definitions, and parts of speech

Grammar: Students will study authentic texts and come to recognize the essential grammar conventions that readers and writers require to make meaning
