# ADVANCED MATH

- Curriculum is a blend of 5th grade review & 6th grade concepts
- Pacing is quicker and more rigorous than previous years.
- Curriculum pace:
  - 1-2 lessons per day in 5th grade book
  - 1 lesson a day in the 6th grade book
- Homework:
  - practice will be given nightly to help students master skills
  - Problem Solving focus
  - Students will be expected to watch the next lesson's video as a preview so we can use our time in class to our advantage.

# ADVANCED MATH

## Assessment:

- Pretest will be given before each new topic
- Tests will be given on paper and online
  - Questions will be the same, just given a work space on the paper copy
- Opportunities for Self-Corrections
  - Test is graded online
  - Paper copy is taken home to make corrections with pen, colored pencil, etc
  - Students will be given partial credit for corrections made
    - This can not be noted in Saavas
  - Corrections are due the next day.

# GRADING

- standards based grades
- Focus is on “Successfully Completed” and “Needs More Practice” sections of assessments
- Homework completion, mid-topic reviews, end of topic assessments make up report card scores

# CLASS EXPECTATIONS

- Come to class prepared each day:
  - Fully charged laptop

  - Homework completed
