2019-20 School Performance Reports

- The School Performance Reports reflect the New Jersey Department of Education's commitment to proving
 parents, students, and school communities with a large variety of information about each school and
 district. These reports can be used as a tool to help evaluate whether all students have equitable access to
 high quality education.
- The 2019-2020 New Jersey School Performance Reports, which were recently released and are available on the NJ School Performance Reports webpage at www.njschooldata.org.
- The ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has had a significant impact on the way the NJDOE was able to measure school performance and student achievement in the 2019-2020 School Performance Reports. Some data is not available at all and other data, while available, may not look the same as it did in prior years.
- The existing data can't begin to measure the hard work and perseverance of the students, families, educators, and community members during this difficult year.
- The reports and resources are also translated into Spanish.

- New resources to help explain the impact of COVID-19 on the availability of data in the reports
- A new narrative field, "Learning During COVID-19" dedicated to individual district responses to the COVID-19 pandemic


Enrollment Trends by Grade

This table shows the number of students enrolled by grade for the past 3 school years



Postsecondary Enrollment

Postsecondary Information from Narrative

- Programs to assist students in applying for college include sponsoring PSAT testing for each student, evening SAT preparation courses, and offering the SAT at a district school.
- Our district graduation rate is 95.3%.
- Of those graduates, 61.4% planned to attend a 4-year college and 38.6% planned to attend a 2-year college, with other students being either undecided or pursuing employment or military service.
- Utilizing the Naviance program helps streamline the intricate application process and identify future goals and majors. District-sponsored college preparation and financial aid programs assist parents in securing the most aid possible.
