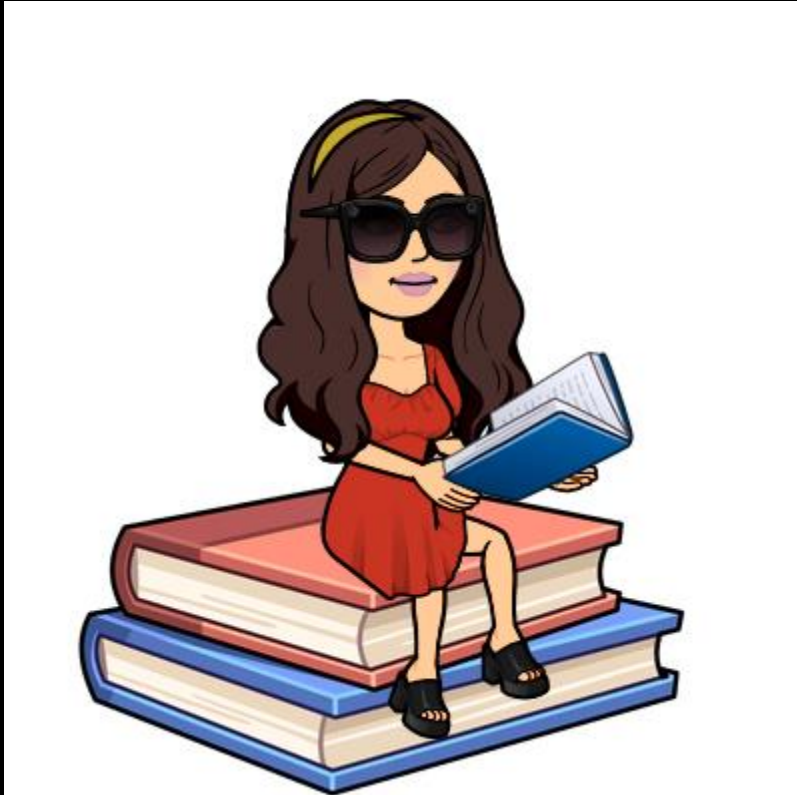
# LITERACY

- 30 minutes every night except for Fridays
- Initialed by a parent/guardian
- Students will log the title of the book, how many pages read, the amount of time they read for, and the date.

- Skills change and groups change based on student needs.

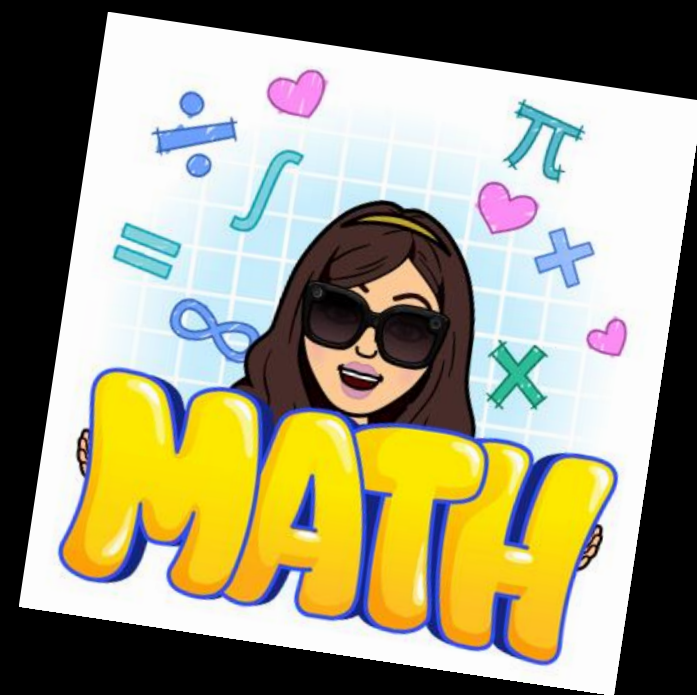

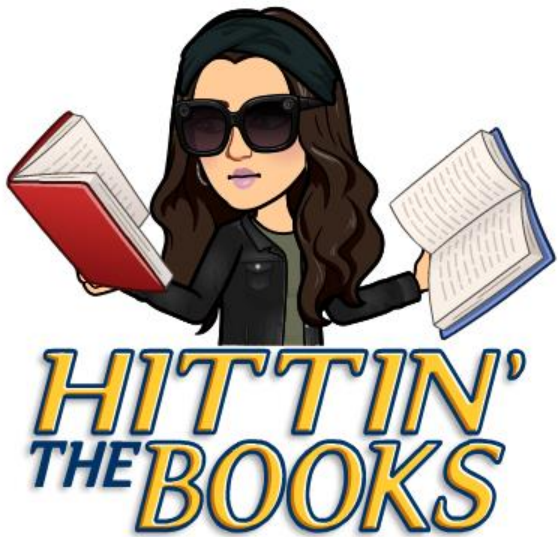
