Structured Literacy

Structured Literacy instructs students in phonemic awareness, word study, and sets the foundation for second grade writing with direct review of handwriting, spelling and basic skills for capitalization and punctuation learned previously, as well as new skills such as working with open & closed syllables, graphemes & more!



Curriculum

HMH Into Reading

- Read Alouds, Shared Reading and Guided Reading Groups are incorporated into reading time.
- Students will be listening to & reading both fiction & nonfiction texts across many genres this year. These genres include informational texts, fantasy texts, poetry and more!
- Students will focus on topics such as finding the main idea and supporting details in a text, elements of different genres of text and more!
- The reading students do will also be connected to our Social & Emotional learning, as well as what we are learning about in Social Studies!
- Students will take the HMH Growth Measure three times throughout the year (beginning, middle & end) to see their progress and growth!

Curriculum

- Our HMH Writing Workshop will focus on writing narratives, writing about what we've read, nonfiction writing, poetry writing and more! We will also do interactive writing and shared writing!




Handwriting

- Practicing letter writing using guides given.

Math



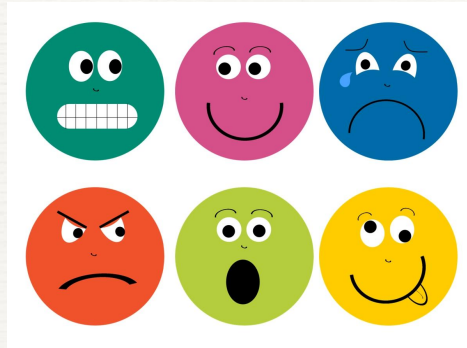
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- **Envision Mathematics**


Social Emotional Learning

Wednesdays: Reading for 20 minutes AND math page sent home!

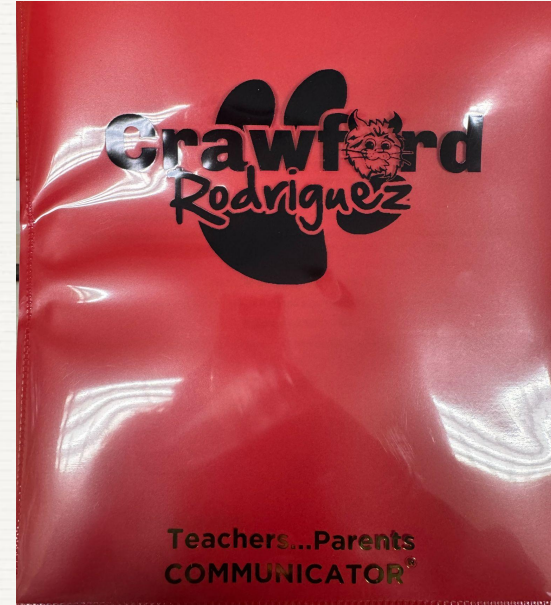
Thursdays: Literacy page AND math page sent home!

Red Crawford Folders

Weekly newsletters will also be posted on Google Classroom & my class page!



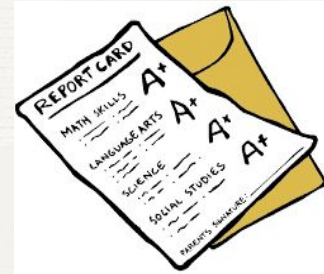
Dismissal
