

## CLASSROOM NEWS \$

#### Week of 3/17 -3/21

Reading: This week, we will continue reading within our fifth reading Module: Going Places. Students will read new genres of texts/types of texts in this Module that they have not been exposed to much before including articles, legends, & opinion writing - as well as reviewing the elements of previously learned genres of texts such as fantasy texts, biographies, dramas, & more! Students will understand being a leader, and throughout this week, they will continue to learn & discuss the qualities that make a good leader. Students will think about what traits they have seen from the characters in stories they have previously read (both good & bad qualities) and how to tell which qualities made a strong leader in those stories (or the qualities that showed that a character may not have been the strongest leader or best influence). We will discuss how to determine if a character is being a positive influence in a story, or if they would not make the best leader. As always, students will also think about the lessons they can learn from the characters in stories (both good & bad), as well as focusing on reading skills such as making inferences about things not specifically noted in the text, understanding text structure/text organization of the story and the purpose for it being written that way, and predicting what may happen next based on context clues.

Structured Literacy (previously known as Phonics): This week, we will focus on the skills of understanding that a constant + -le ending in a word creates a final stable syllable in which the consonant & I make their sounds but the e is silent!

Module 4 Heart Words of the week: other & another

(students should still be able to recognize Module 1 heart words: been, into, two & very; Module 2 heart words: about, around, away, nothing, woman & women; Module 3 heart words: buy, guy, anyone, anything; Module 4 heart words: says, busy, business, above & among; AND Module 5 heart word: because).

<u>Math</u>: This week, we will continue working more within Topic 8: Work With Time & Money. Students will review additional skills & strategies learned to tell time on a clock as well as count and add/subtract money!

<u>Science</u>: This week, we will continue working within our science unit on Ecosystems.

Students will learn what an ecosystem is, how ecosystems are different and specific to the plants & animals living in them, and what an ecosystem needs to thrive & survive – meaning what do the plants & animals in that ecosystem need in order to livel Students will learn about all different elements of an ecosystem, both living & nonliving!
