Reading: Continuing to read more favorite storybooks to enhance our reading skills and practice new skills such as reading effectively with a partner, using exact words that characters use, sounding out unknown words, and more. We will continue to work to understand characters' feelings in stories and how those feelings can change throughout the story, as well as understanding the mood of a story and how that mood can shift, helping us to identify the problem/solution of the story. In addition, we will keep working on the reading skills we have learned throughout this unit, such as looking at pictures to help us read, rereading to make the words match the pictures in the story, acting out how a character is feeling, talking like a character, pointing and reading words in stories (especially sight words) and more!

<u>Phonics</u>: Continuing to practice echoing, tracing, and proper formation of sky-line & plane-line letters as well as learning new letter sounds & how to write new sky-line letters LI (/I/), Hh (/h/) AND Kk (/k/). SIGHT WORDS OF THE WEEK: has & was.

<u>Math</u>: Beginning Topic 5: Classify & Count Data – Students will work to classify objects into categories based on a certain characteristics and tell why those objects belong in those categories. Students will also compare how many objects are in different categories. <u>Social Studies:</u> Beginning Unit 2: Family, Culture & Heritage – In this unit, students will discuss who is apart of their family, as well as learning how families and family traditions can be unique based on different cultures & heritages. We will also discuss all of the holidays that different cultures may celebrate around this time of year!
