CAFE Empower Financial Literacy Program

O.C.E.A.N. Inc. provided over 150 eligible individuals with financial literacy through on-line modules in partnership with 1st Bergen Federal Credit Union to gain financial empowerment. Each eligible individual who completed the financial literacy program, received a \$50 Wawa or Shop Rite gift card, met one on one with a personal banker and received a \$1,000

Shop with A Cop

Shop with a Cop is an event where uniformed police officers and volunteers assist eligible children with their holiday shopping, free of charge to the child and their families within Atlantic, Ocean and Cape May counties. Shop with a Cop promotes social justice and positive police relationships for families as they gain the skills, knowledge and enhance their ability to engage within the Throughout community. shopping spree, police officers were paired with a child, items pre-scanned and calculated their assigned child's order to ensure they were within \$150 before proceeding to the checkout. While shopping, officers engaged in conversation with each child while shopping and selecting their holiday gifts.

Once at the register, O.C.E.A.N. Inc. presented each child's

family/guardian with a \$50 Shoprite Gift Card to assist with food insecurities.

Hearing and Visions Services in The Community

Healthy vision supports learning, early literacy skills, social and emotional development, motor skills, physical activity, and selfimage. It is not always easy to tell when children have difficulty seeing because many vision problems are invisible. Therefore, vision screening throughout early childhood is important to identify and ensure treatment of vision disorders. O.C.E.A.N. Inc. Head Start nursing department assisted with training district nurses on hearing and vision equipment to complete screenings throughout partnership pre-school programs.

Holiday Assistance

All Head Start families received a \$50 holiday assistance gift card to help combat food insecurities and ensure families can have a meal together for the holiday.

Housing Program

The goal of the Housing Division of O.C.E.A.N., Inc. is to increase the supply of safe, sanitary and affordable housing in Ocean, Monmouth and Atlantic Counties and expand access to affordable housing for low-income households.

LIHEAP and USF (Low Income Home Energy Assistance and Universal Service Fund)

The Home Energy Assistance and Universal Service Fund programs provide assistance to households that meet the Federal Government income guidelines (200% for poverty Home Energy Assistance and State income guidelines 175% of poverty for Universal Service Fund) and are unable to pay their heating bill due to hardship or circumstances beyond their control. Assistance is provided through a one-time payment in a given heating season for Home Energy. Universal Service Funds are monthly credits based on eligibility income, other benefits received and utility usage consecutive 12 months. Amount of Universal Service Fund is determined by the utility company.

First Time Home Buyers Program
