
Overall Goals

Reading Inventory

The Reading Inventory is a computer-adaptive assessment designed to measure how well students read literature and expository text of varying difficulties. Students will take the SRI test three times this year. Once in September, once in January and once again in May. You will receive a letter each time explaining their scores and where their lexile level places them.


