Grade

The primary goal of this ensemble is to expose Jackson Memorial students to the genre of jazz, for the first time or for experienced players looking to further their knowledge of jazz music. The group looks to cultivate those skills necessary to be successful in the jazz idiom, such as the development of improvisation techniques, the acquisition of appropriate music theory knowledge, or learning to play the instruments associated with the jazz big band (saxophone, trumpet, trombone, guitar, vibes, etc).

Entry into the ensemble is not based on audition, however Mr. Ficarra may invite students to come down and play their instrument for him to see where they fit best within the Jazz Lab.

The ensemble is also not reserved for music students only – anyone can join!

The Jazz Lab will be performing at the **Jackson Memorial Spring Band Concert** on May 21, as well as the annual **Jackson Liberty Jazz Festival** on April 21!

MEMBERSHIP/ATTENDANCE POLICY
