Classroom Rules:

1. There will be homework most nights and all students are expected to complete the assignment by the next class. If you should be absent, you are responsible for getting the assignment and completing it by the **next day**. A **zero** will be entered into the grade book and will be changed once the assignment is turned in. Work **will not be accepted** at the end of the marking period. You should get a copy of a classmate's notes so you don't fall behind. Most Chapters will have Challenge homework assignments that are graded. These are not allowed to be turned in late.
2. Please arrive to class on time. If you are late for class more than two times, you will be asked to stay after school for detention. We have a lot of material to cover, in a short amount of time, so it is imperative that everyone arrives on time.
3. Students must complete tests and quizzes during the allotted class time, you are not given extra time after school to complete the assessments. If work is not shown on any graded assignments including tests, quizzes, classwork and homework you **will not receive credit for the work**. If anyone is caught cheating on a test or quiz you will receive a zero and will not be able to make up the assessment.
4. Please be prepared for class. Being prepared means have homework, text book, notebook, **pencils**, and any other materials that are necessary for class with you upon arrival. I consider this is your assignment every day and it is a part of your homework grade.
5. Please avoid private conversations during the class period since this is distracting to me and to other students. If this becomes an ongoing problem, it will result in detention.
6. Cell phones (and any other electronic equipment) are not permitted and will be confiscated, only to be released to a parent or guardian. You may only use cell phones when I ask you to do so. Cell phones will be turned in on test and quiz days.
7. Extra help is available Monday, Wednesday and Thursday during the flex period. I encourage all students to take advantage of this.
8. Portal will be updated several days a week. Please make sure you log on to view your grade.
