Welcome parents and guardians!


I'm Miss Murga; it's so nice to meet all of you.

This will be my seventeenth year teaching and my tenth year at Goetz Middle school in the Technology Department.





7th Grade Tech - This course focuses on invention and innovation including product development, design and marketing.





8th Grade Digital Photo - This course introduces students to the basics of Digital Photography, including camera handling and functions, image editing, visual aesthetics and composition.







8th Grade Computer Programming - This course introduces students to the basics of computer programming vocabulary, skills and techniques that incorporate critical thinking and problem solving using simple coding language blocks to create interactive media. Students will use a web based program called Scratch to design original animated stories, games, simulations and more.





8th Grade Community Leadership - This course introduces students to real world social issues and works to expand problem solving skills, to develop an action plan and to verbally present a potential solution. This course will expand one's ability to research, debate, work collaboratively and present their plan of action.

You are encouraged to check the Genesis parent portal for grades and/or missing assignments regularly.


I update grades at least once per week.
