Students will not be admitted after 7:30 PM and are not permitted to leave and return to the dance. While at the dance, students will be asked to maintain a proper social distance as best as possible. Dancing with a certain group of students may limit the number of students who will need to quarantine should a positive COVID case be reported.

In the event a student tests positive for COVID or exhibits symptoms that are reported to our staff, nurses and administrators will conduct interviews to determine who may be considered a close contact and may need to quarantine due to contact tracing.

By signing this form, you give permission to attend the homecoming dance and understand the possibility that your child may be required to quarantine due to testing positive for COVID or from being determined to be a close contact of a COVID positive student.
