# PLANNING FOR ARRIVAL

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## Arrival Protocol:

- > Parents must complete a daily, student, health-screening form on the Parent Portal to allow student entry into the classroom. More details and a sample of the form will be provided by the district this week.
- > Students will be escorted or guided by staff from the bus to the grade-level assigned door when arriving at Johnson.
- > Grade-level specific entrances and have been assigned.
- > Masks will be worn during all transitions.

## Parent Drop Off:

- > Parents will utilize front entrance from 9:10 to 9:25 am for parent drop offs.
- > All students dropped off in the front will be guided into the building right to their classroom.
- > Students arriving after 9:25 will need to be brought to the main entrance.
- > Staff will be on duty to assist with student transitions.





## Safety Protocols

Staggered entry/exit.

Practice social distancing.

Masks required while transitioning.

Mask Breaks provided at teacher's discretion.

No visitors allowed.

Clearly marked directional signs.

Teacher created bathroom schedule.

Wash hands before/after transitions.

Bathrooms cleaned on a schedule.

Visitations will be limited and by appointment.

Students encouraged to bring own water bottles.

Water fountains will be used as refilling stations as needed.

Box lunch provided with limited choices



## PLANNING FOR ELECTIVES AND SPECIAL AREAS

SC classes will join remotely from school.

Chorus will occur remotely and be reevaluated for the 2020-21 School Year.
