Homemade Watercolor Paints and Brushes







If you have dried out markers laying around the house, instead of throwing them away, you can make your own watercolor paint.

- 1. Test the marker to make sure its dry.
- 2. Let it sit in water for a few days. Make sure to use an old container or plastic cup. Are some colors darker? Lighter?
- 3. Once it starts to look like paint- paint away. Use items around the house to make your own paintbrushes too!
