

# How to Apply for Online Ocean County Library Card for Jackson Students

## **What Teachers Need to Know:**

- Students should fill out the online form at home to acquire the e-signature needed for Parental consent.
- A school email address is sufficient proof of address for students
- Depending on how many cards need to be created, this process may take a few weeks for the physical cards to be ready to pick up, but the library barcode may be used as soon as it is emailed to the student, within a few days of application.
- Teachers can pick up cards designated for their class to pass out to students in class, but students can continue to use library barcode remotely if the card cannot get to them during the school year.
- Cards can be picked up in the Youth Services Desk at the Jackson Branch of the Ocean County Library.

## **What Students Need to Know:**

- If you already have an Ocean County Library Card you can use the current barcode to access any of our digital materials or databases.
- If you **do not have** an Ocean County Library Card or if you are **not sure** if you have an Ocean County Library Card, please complete the online application. We will email you either a new card number or your old one for use.
  - Please fill out the form with your parent or guardian.
  - Please include your school address in the Alternate address line.
  - Select “Yes” for “Are you currently a student in grade PreK-12?” and include your school district, school, as well as your teacher’s name.
  - Select “Yes” for “Would you Like your Library Barcode emailed to you?” and use your school email address.


