

# Homemade Watercolor Paints and Brushes



If you have dried out markers laying around the house, instead of throwing them away, you can make your own watercolor paint.

1. Test the marker to make sure its dry.
2. Let it sit in water for a few days. Make sure to use an old container or plastic cup. Are some colors darker? Lighter?
3. Once it starts to look like paint- paint away. Use items around the house to make your own paintbrushes too!
