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Classroom Rules and Procedures

- ❖ **Be respectful:** You are expected to be quiet, attentive, respectful, and courteous during class. No inappropriate behavior and/or language will be tolerated. Inappropriate actions will have such consequences as teacher detention, parent notification, and administration involvement.

- ❖ **Homework:** Homework will be assigned daily. It must be completed in your notebook or on graph paper when needed and will be checked everyday. Each assignment must have on it the date, assignment number, page numbers and questions answered. You will be given partial credit for assignments that are incomplete or illegible. NO late assignments will be accepted!!
- ❖ **Show ALL work:** On ALL assignments, you must show all of your work neatly to receive credit. No credit will be given for papers with just the answers shown.
- ❖ **When absent:** All class work and homework missed must be completed promptly after returning to school. It is your responsibility to continue working through the chapter and to get missed class notes/videos of the lesson and homework from the **GOOGLE CLASSROOM**.
- ❖ **Tests/Big Quizzes:** If you are absent on a review day, you will take the test with the class. If you are absent on a test day, you will take the test the next day you arrive back to school.
