## Classroom Rules and Procedures

- ❖ **Be respectful:** You are expected to be quiet, attentive, respectful, and courteous during class. No inappropriate behavior and/or language will be tolerated. Inappropriate actions will have such consequences as teacher detention, parent notification, and administration involvement.

- ❖ **Supplies:** You must bring to class everyday the following materials: pencils, highlighters, spiral notebook or 3 ring binder- 1 to 2 inches, loose leaf, graph paper, graphing calculator (preferably TI 84PlusCE) CHARGED.
- ❖ **Homework:** Homework will be assigned daily. It must be completed in your notebook or on graph paper when needed and will be checked everyday. Each assignment must have on it the date, assignment number, page numbers and questions answered. You will be given partial credit for assignments that are incomplete or illegible. NO late assignments will be accepted!!
- ❖ **Show ALL work:** On ALL assignments, you must show all of your work neatly to receive credit. No credit will be given for papers with just the answers shown. You must show the appropriate steps to arrive at the solution!
- ❖ **Group work:** All students are expected to be active, contributing members in their assigned group settings.
- ❖ **When absent:** All class work and homework missed must be completed promptly after returning to school. It is your responsibility to continue working through the chapter and to get missed class notes and homework from a classmate or the classpage. Assignments and upcoming quizzes and tests will be posted on Google Classroom. Your class code is qv7cofp.

### Grades:

- ❖ Each marking period (3) is determined by your performance in many areas. It is calculated as follows:
  - (60%) Tests, Big Quizzes
  - (20%) Participation Quizzes (announced or unannounced), Collected Homework, Class Work, Group Work
